Faces of the Community is a socially dynamic and timely fine art exhibition focusing on cultural awareness and the wonderful diversity of our community through the medium of portraiture in all fine art mediums. AAWS invites members to submit up to two works of artwork focused on the theme of portraiture as well as a brief statement about their personal approach to the practice of creating a portrait. This Exhibition will be held in the Womble Carlyle Gallery inside the Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts.

ELIGIBILITY

Any member of Associated Artists of Winston-Salem may enter this exhibition.

Entry fee: \$15 for up to 2 entries

- Artwork should fit the theme of Portraiture.
- All artwork must be original.
- 3D art must be able to hang or sit on a flat surface.
- Installation & site-specific artwork proposals, if selected must be installed by the artist.
- Please refer to our website AssociatedArtists.org for more information detailing our insurance & liability for artwork in our exhibitions.
- Artwork previously exhibited in the Womble Carlyle Gallery may not be shown.

HOW TO ENTER

Please email us your note of intent to lnfo@AssociatedArtists.org with "Faces of the Community" in the subject line of your email by February 5.

Include the following in with your note of intent.

- Titles, medium, size and prices of your art.
- If your work is not for sale, please include the insurance value of the piece.
- A brief statement about your approach to portraiture and your artistic process.

PROMOTIONAL IMAGES

AAWS will use up to three images to represent the exhibit in event promotions. If you would like to submit your work for consideration, please email a high-resolution image of the piece with your note of intent email and written permission for us to do so.

When taking photos of your work please keep the following in mind.

- Crop the image to show only the artwork unless the frame is part of the work of art.
- Make sure your photos are in focus. Use a tripod.
- Avoid taking photos of your work from odd angles.
- Give your work the documentation it deserves and consider having your work professionally photographed.

COMMISSION

Artists set the sales price. The artist will receive 70% of the price and AAWS will retain 30%. North Carolina sales tax is added to the sales price. All artists must complete an inventory sheet and label their work properly to exhibit. If the work is not for sale, please mark as NFS and include an insurance value.

DROP OFF

Please bring properly completed inventory sheets & labels for artworks to expedite the drop off process. All artwork should be dropped off at the Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts at 251 N. Spruce Street, Winston-Salem, NC 270101.

PICK UP

Please deliver and pick up work during the designated times. Late work will not be accepted. Works brought before or left after designated dates are NOT covered by insurance. There will be a \$20 per week storage and handling fee for works brought more than 7 days before the delivery date or left more than 7 days after the pick-up date. Works left for more than 90 days after the pick-up date become the property of AAWS. If you have special circumstances regarding art drop off or pick up, please contact the AAWS office in advance.
