CALL FOR ENTRIES: *Relevance 2018* is a new juried arts exhibition for college students presented by the Associated Artists of Winston-Salem and The Arts Council of Winston-Salem/Forsyth County. The exhibition is organized by students at Salem College. The goals of this exhibition are to build community and bring attention to the wonderfully inventive and relevant artwork being created by local college artists.

ELIGIBILITY: College students attending any four-year or two-year accredited college or university in Forsyth County are invited submit ONE piece of artwork that meets the following criteria: 2D and 3D art in any medium (2D pieces do not have to be framed); pieces must be less than 52” wide and/or weigh no more than 300 lbs; must be original work; created within the past 3 years; does not contain overt political, sexual, or violent imagery. (A current student ID is required. If the artwork is delivered by someone other than the student, a copy of the student ID will be acceptable.)

TO ENTER: Artists must bring their art, a \$5 entry fee (CASH OR CHECK ONLY) and college ID (or photocopy of ID), plus artwork labels (provided at the end of this document) during delivery dates/times as listed in the Calendar below to: The Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts; 251 N. Spruce Street; Winston-Salem, NC 27101. (NOTE: In lieu of paying the entry fee an entrant may choose to register as a member of AAWS for \$20 and receive FREE entry to this exhibit and full membership benefits for a year. JUROR: The juror will be Mary Anne Redding, Assistant Director and Curator of the Turchin Center for Visual Arts at Appalachian State University. Ms. Redding will also attend the opening reception on Nov 2.

SALES: Artists set their own prices. Artists receive 70% of the sales price; AAWS retains a 30% commission. North Carolina sales tax is added to the sales price. Keeping these conditions in mind, artists should calculate their prices to include commission and tax. Artists will be notified of sales within 1-2 business days of the completed transaction.

DELIVERY/STORAGE OF ACCEPTED ART: Artists are responsible for their own insurance. All accepted work must remain at the Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts for the duration of the show. Please deliver and pick up work during the designated times. Late work will not be accepted. There will be a \$10 per week storage and handling fee for works brought more than 7 days before the delivery date or left more than 7 days after the pick-up date. Works left for more than 90 days after the pick-up date become the property of AAWS. If you have special circumstances regarding art delivery/drop off or pick up/return, please contact the AAWS office in advance.

ELIGIBILITY, INSURANCE, AND LIABILITY: AAWS will take every reasonable precaution to prevent loss of or damage to your work, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage. AAWS carries insurance only during dates of exhibition (installation and uninstallation dates not included). If work is not for sale, provide us with the insurance value. Insurance value of selected works should be reasonable and may be questioned in the event of a claim. Proof of previous sales prices may be requested. Our policy protects against mysterious disappearance, vandalism, and water or fire damage, but does not cover breakage. The offending party is liable and responsible for any damage caused. Associated Artists, the Arts Administration Department of Salem College, and the Arts Council are not responsible for artwork that is broken while in the Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts. AAWS reserves the right to remove any works at any point in time.
