**CALL FOR ENTRIES:** **Summer in The City** is an exhibit and sale of fine art by members of Associated Artists of Winston-Salem. **Open to all AAWS members**, who may each submit up to three (3) pieces of two-dimensional (2-D) art.

**Entry Fee:** \$15 for up to 3 pieces

**Entry Deadline:** Thursday, June 24

**Volunteers Needed to Help Hang the Show:** Saturday, June 26 beginning at Noon

**TO ENTER:** Please email your completed, signed Inventory Card to [Info@AssociatedArtists.org](mailto:Info@AssociatedArtists.org) with **“Summer in The City” in the subject line.** Entries must be emailed no later than Midnight, Thursday, June 24, and **must conform to ALL of the requirements below.**

**ENTRY FEE:** The \$15 entry fee may be paid in advance online by PayPal or credit card, or by cash or check at art drop-off.

**To pay online by PayPal or with a credit card:** Visit [www.AssociatedArtists.org/donate](http://www.AssociatedArtists.org/donate) and click on “Click Here to Donate Now.” This will take you to PayPal where you can either pay through PayPal or with a credit or debit card. Enter the exact entry fee amount (\$15.00). **Entry fees are due no later than art drop-off or you will not be eligible to exhibit.** Membership must be current for 2021.

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:** Two-dimensional (2-D) works in all fine-art media are eligible for this exhibit, with the following provisions: No piece may exceed 50 inches horizontally including frame, or 50 pounds in weight. All works must be framed in a professional manner with wire attachment and be ready to hang. No “alligator” type hangers. Canvases must be framed, or gallery wrapped with no visible staples or unpainted canvas. Canvases with wet paint will not be accepted. Works on paper should be protected by glass or Plexiglas. Improperly presented work will not be exhibited. All work entered must be original art created by the artist and cannot have been displayed in any previous AAWS exhibit at the Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts that lasted at least a month. Mass-produced printed reproductions of paintings or drawings will not be exhibited. Hand-pulled prints, original digital prints and photographs are all acceptable. All work must be the exhibitor’s original idea and be created by the exhibitor.

**SALES:** Artists set their own prices. Artist receives 70% of the sales price; AAWS retains a 30% commission. North Carolina sales tax is added to the sales price. If your work is not for sale, please include the insurance value and designate as not for sale (NFS) on the Inventory Card.

**NEW: PROMOTIONAL IMAGES / Virtual Exhibits:** For the Online Virtual Gallery, please include jpgs of your submissions, with your last name and the picture title as the file name – e.g., “Smith\_Deep Forest.” This is NOT mandatory, but helps to get the exhibit on the website quicker. This is especially necessary if your work is behind glass. Submit a photo with as little reflection as possible. AAWS reserves the right to use photos of accepted works for promotional purposes and display them online in Virtual Tours and Exhibits.

**INVENTORY CARD AND ART LABEL:** Please fill out the Inventory Card below completely with information exactly as you wish it to appear on the wall label, sign it and email a PDF or JPG image of the signed sheet, along with jpg images of the works you are entering, to [Info@AssociatedArtists.org](mailto:Info@AssociatedArtists.org) **“Summer in The City” in the subject line** by Midnight, Thursday, June 24. **Please be sure to bring the original copy of your signed Inventory Card with you when you drop off your work.** Affix the Art Label to the back of each entry. (If for any reason you cannot attach a PDF or JPG of your signed Inventory Card to the email, put your full name and address, and a numbered inventory with all of the information from the Inventory Card in the body of the email. And also bring the original copy of your signed Inventory Card to drop off.

**ART DROP OFF AND PICK UP:** Please deliver and pick up work during the designated times. Late work will not be accepted. We cannot store art left after the show is over. **If you have special circumstances regarding art drop-off or pick-up, please contact the AAWS office in advance at: [info@AssociatedArtists.org](mailto:info@AssociatedArtists.org) no later than June 24 to make other arrangements.**

**INSURANCE:** AAWS and the Arts Council will take every reasonable precaution to prevent loss of, or damage to, your work, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage. Your personal homeowners' or renter's insurance policy may provide coverage of your artwork. Check with your insurance agent.

**ABOUT ASSOCIATED ARTISTS:** Associated Artists of Winston-Salem is among the largest membership organizations for visual artists in the Piedmont Triad of North Carolina. Established in 1956, AAWS' mission is to support and celebrate the visual artist, from the aspiring to the professional. We host group exhibitions in our main exhibit spaces in the Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts, the Masonic Center of Winston-Salem and The Benton Convention Center, and solo or two-person community exhibits at restaurants, businesses, offices and other organizations throughout the greater Winston-Salem area. As we recover, we hope to once again offer hands-on workshops, where members can grow and develop as professionals in their chosen media. and we encourage participation in volunteer opportunities.
